Katrina turns on the water at Grabine Lakeside Holiday and Recreation Park

Member for Burrinjuck, Katrina Hodgkinson has announced the \$568,700 water treatment plant at Grabine Lakeside Holiday & Recreation Park is now operational.

The installation of the water treatment plant was proudly managed by the NSW Department of Trade and Investment and the NSW Crown Holiday Parks Trust (NSW CHPT).

NSW CHPT was established in 2013 to consolidate the operations and management of twenty six coastal and nine inland holiday parks and reserves located on Crown land in some of the State's most iconic locations.

Katrina said the Grabine water treatment plant was part of a \$12 million program funded by the Government's Public Reserves Management Fund to upgrade and renew utilities at the inland parks managed by the Trust.

"Grabine Lakeside Holiday and Recreation Park has long been a favourite holiday destination for families and now they'll be able to turn on the tap and know that the water is clean and fresh and meets Australian Drinking Water Standards.

"Providing water to this standard will improve the visitor experience at the park which is an important part of the local tourist economy.

"The upgrade of Grabine Lakeside Holiday & Recreation Park is just one example of the NSW Government's commitment to the cultural, sporting, economic and recreational life of communities across NSW," Katrina said.

"I thank the Minister for Natural Resources, Lands and Water, Kevin Humphries for his support of this important local infrastructure project."

NSW CHPT CEO Steve Edmonds said the Trust was proud to help deliver such an important initiative in providing clean and fresh drinking water for Grabine Lakeside Holiday & Recreation Park guests. "AquaManage, the company responsible for the water treatment plant's construction is to be congratulated for their successful completion of the project."
